INTRODUCTIONS (Agenda Item 1)

The meeting opened with a welcome from the Chairman and introductions around the table.

MINUTES OF THE NEIGHBOURHOOD ACTION GROUP (Agenda item 3)

It was proposed by the Chairman Cllr M Brossard and the following was

NEIGHBOURHOOD POLICE REPORT (Agenda item 4)

The Police report was received in detail and covered a range of recent operations. These included the arrest of two individuals responsible for stealing high-end mountain bikes, a criminal behaviour order being issued on a local resident who has been falsifying assault claims and the arrest of a driver acting suspiciously around teenage girls.

A discussion took place about the recent wildlife attacks in the park, further to the discussion it was proposed by PC Campion and the following was

that an update on the prosecution of the individuals arrested will be provided in the next meeting by PC Campion.

Further to resolution 0461 it was reported that SID has been recovered and repaired by Cllr M Brossard. The charger was still missing and Cllr M Brossard may have a spare in his garage. An update on current resourcing from PC Campion was given and it was agreed that deployment of SID be arranged upon the equipment being fully functional.



BRANKSOME HILL ROAD AND COLLEGE ROAD (Agenda item 5)

Further to resolution 560 the response from BFC had been received. It was confirmed that a 20mph zone was introduced recently outside the school in Branksome Hill Road " As part of the 20 zone regulations we were required to look at ways to get speeds down further hence the replacement of the 50mm high speed humps with new 75mm high speed cushions, as specified to the contractor, with gateway signs etc to try and make this particular area stand out environmentally from the rest of the road and to indicate to motorists that greater care should be taken."

CYCLING IN SANDHURST (Agenda item 6)

Further to resolution 462 an update on the Borough plans to improve cycle paths was given. An improvement to South Road cycle paths in conjunction with the Broadmoor re-development is planned. Overhanging shrubbery onto the cycle paths by the Meadows as well as rubble and traffic signs in cycle lanes were reported. Further to discussion it was proposed by Cllr M Brossard and the following was

Cllr M Brossard will consult with the Borough about the obstructions on the pathways and an update will be provided.

The need to have residents involved was discussed and the residents associations were asked to consider representatives for the meeting. Going forward there will be experts to help but work is needed at a local level involving residents to begin the plan.

HGV USE OF RESIDENTIAL ROADS (Agenda item 9)

It was reported that the highways department have declined the suggestion to display 7.5 tonne limit signs on Yeovil Road. Further to the discussion it was proposed by Cllr A Blatchford and the following was
