1. Purpose of report

To apprise the councillors of a request from a member of the public.

2. Background

The following request has been received from a local resident-

I am a resident of Alford Close and a director on our management team. I would like to know whether it is possible to install a public waste bin that the council would manage. Since the development of Sandhurst Gardens began over 2 years ago there has been an increasing footfall between that estate and our own. During the last 12 months in particular the quantity of rubbish (including dog waste) left in this area has reached a worrying and unmanageable level.

It should not be the responsibility of a resident in this road to collect and dispose of rubbish, something which I have been doing in recent months.

I would welcome your advice and help with this matter.

The costs to STC for installing the bin and providing the emptying of the bin will be –

Circa £350 to purchase the bin, plus £276 per year to have the bin emptied.

3. Recommendation
