1. Purpose of report

To apprise the Committee of a request from a member of the public for a bench to be installed in Sandhurst Town.

2. Background

A request has been received from a resident asking for STC to consider installing a bench at the bus stop at Harts Leap Road. He says many people need a rest while they climb the hill especially the elderly.

The bus stop does not have a shelter due to the very limited space at the site.



3. Recommendation

The site requested is unsuitable for a bench. STC could consider other nearby sites including the replacement of a BFC bench at York Way, although this would replace an existing bench rather than provide an extra one.
