

## **POLICY RE ELECTRIC BARRIER**

### **BROOKSIDE MEADOW**

Due to the existing padlocked barrier being continually left open by users of the facility, which left the park vulnerable to unauthorised vehicles entering it was resolved by Sandhurst Town Council that an electric barrier would be installed.

- The barrier will be activated by a fob. After entrance or exit the barrier will automatically close.
- Fobs will be issued to the following park users:
  - Tug of War
  - S B Sport & Education Group
  - Sandhurst & District Gardening Club
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Sandhurst Scouts
  - Guides
  - Sandhurst Allotment Association
- The Chairman of each club/association will provide STC with a list of requirements for fobs.
- Fobs will only be issued to individuals and the named individual will be responsible for the fob and any actions that occur connected to the fob usage.
- Fobs should not be given to others to use, by the fob holder.
- Fobs will be allocated to the individuals by STC. A signature for receipt of the fob will be required.
- A record of the fob number issued to each individual will be held by STC.
- Allowing others to tailgate through the barrier is not permitted.
- Users must not exceed the 10mph speed limit.
- The individual will be held responsible for any misuse of the fob.
- Misuse will result in the fob being revoked from the individual.
- Continued misuse by members may result in a club having all fobs revoked.
- Any lost fobs will be replaced and a charge of £50.00 will be payable from the individual.
- STC will be the only fob holder with the ability to hold the gate in a permanently open or closed position. This setting will be used for events and will be supervised.
